During the next year, I will use my "Presidential Authority" to set the rules for the way we handle the Fine Free Button (FFB). Accordingly, the following will constitute the Rules for Fine Free.

- The FFB will be auctioned off at the end of the final meeting of each month to be effective the next meeting. The winner of the auction will become the "legitimate" holder of the button for the following month unless the FFB is transferred to another member according to the rules below.
- If the FFB is transferred from the current holder to another member, the Secretary shall be notified at the start of the meeting and a \$20.00 transfer fee will be assessed to the receiving member.
- If the FFB is passed to another member without notification to the Secretary, the transfer will be null and void and the previous "legitimate" holder will be fine free for that meeting.
- If the FFB is not at the final meeting of the month for the auction, the winner of the auction will be deemed to have the FFB. The "former legitimate" holder will be assessed a \$10.00 transfer fee and will be responsible to get the actual button to the winner.
- If the President assesses the "legitimate" holder of the Fine Free Button a fine, the fine shall be paid by the President.
